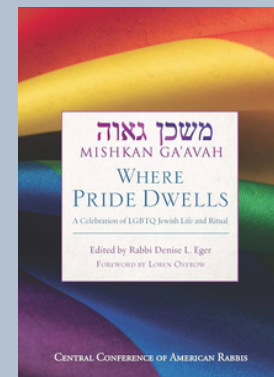

In Jewish tradition, we use Yahrzeit plaques to remember loved ones in perpetuity. On the Memorial Wall in our Sanctuary, Yahrzeit plaques are installed alphabetically by last name, each with a memorial light that is lit for all Yizkor services and on the Shabbat closest to the anniversary of a loved one's death.

Now is the time to order Yahrzeit plaques to ensure installation for the High Holy Days.
